The meeting convened at 10 am with prayer.

Rev. Bill Fulton welcomed everyone.

New Facilities – John Stockwell

Major construction on the new church is complete. Work on the grounds and the final finishes on the interior are progressing. Projected completion date is the first week in March 2019.

Stewardship and Treasurer's Report – Jim Foley

Jim reported on the Time and Talent forms, the congregational surveys, and pledge cards that were turned in by members of the congregation. Plate and pledges are up compared to last year. He discussed in detail the budget for 2019.

There were no nominations from the floor. It was moved, seconded and passed that each of the four persons listed on the slate be approved for a three year term.

Election of Diocesan Convention Delegates and Alternates

Maggie Scott spoke about the importance of St. Antony's having delegates and alternates to the Annual Diocesan Convention. The 2019 convention will be November 8 and 9 in Lynnwood. The nominees for convention delegates were Declan Jarry-Wilkinson and Carolyn Sorrell. The alternate delegate nominees were Blaine Morgan and Sylvia Campbell. It was moved, seconded and passed that the slate of delegates and alternates be accepted.

Bill Fulton thanked Sarah Rogers for serving as Bishop's Warden in 2018. David Wilkinson will be the Bishop's Warden for 2019.
