We missed our contribution target by a little, and incurred some large expenses; including nearly \$4k to move the electrical panel at the old church (condition of sale, not budgeted, but funds set aside for); and nearly \$3k for the water bill. These contributed to putting us in the hole by (\$11,343.53) for the month, and (\$1,484.04) for the year. The good news is at this point we were budgeted to be (\$3,483.03) in the hole, so we are actually ahead of plan still YTD.

I've included both July's and August's bank statements. Note there is no savings account statement as they usually only release one quarterly.
