With February comes Lent! Our Lenten fast begins with Ash Wednesday on February 18th, with services at noon and 7. Our service at noon will be primarily spoken, and our 7pm service will feature hymns and music from the choir.

Before we begin our fast, we hope you will join us on Tuesday, February 17th from 5-7pm, for the traditional Shrove Tuesday pancake supper! You can read more about that tradition [here](#). I also invite anyone who is interested to join me in the picnic shelter after you've enjoyed your pancakes for the burning of last year's Palm Sunday palms into the ashes we will wear on our foreheads the following day. Wear something you don't mind smelling like smoke!

For those of you who like to take on a Lenten daily devotional, I invite you to read along with me this book by Bishop Mulally, the incoming and historic first female Archbishop of Canterbury: *Rooted in Love: Lent Reflections on Life in Christ*. What we know, and many people know, is that sometimes grief is easier to shoulder among friends and with those who are also experiencing grief.

In the spirit of this discussion, the Pastoral Care Committee has decided to put together a survey to see if there is interest in creating this kind of resource here in our church. We would very much appreciate it if church members would fill out this survey to give us an idea of interest. There are a few different options we are discussing and we hope with your feedback we can meet the needs of those within our community.

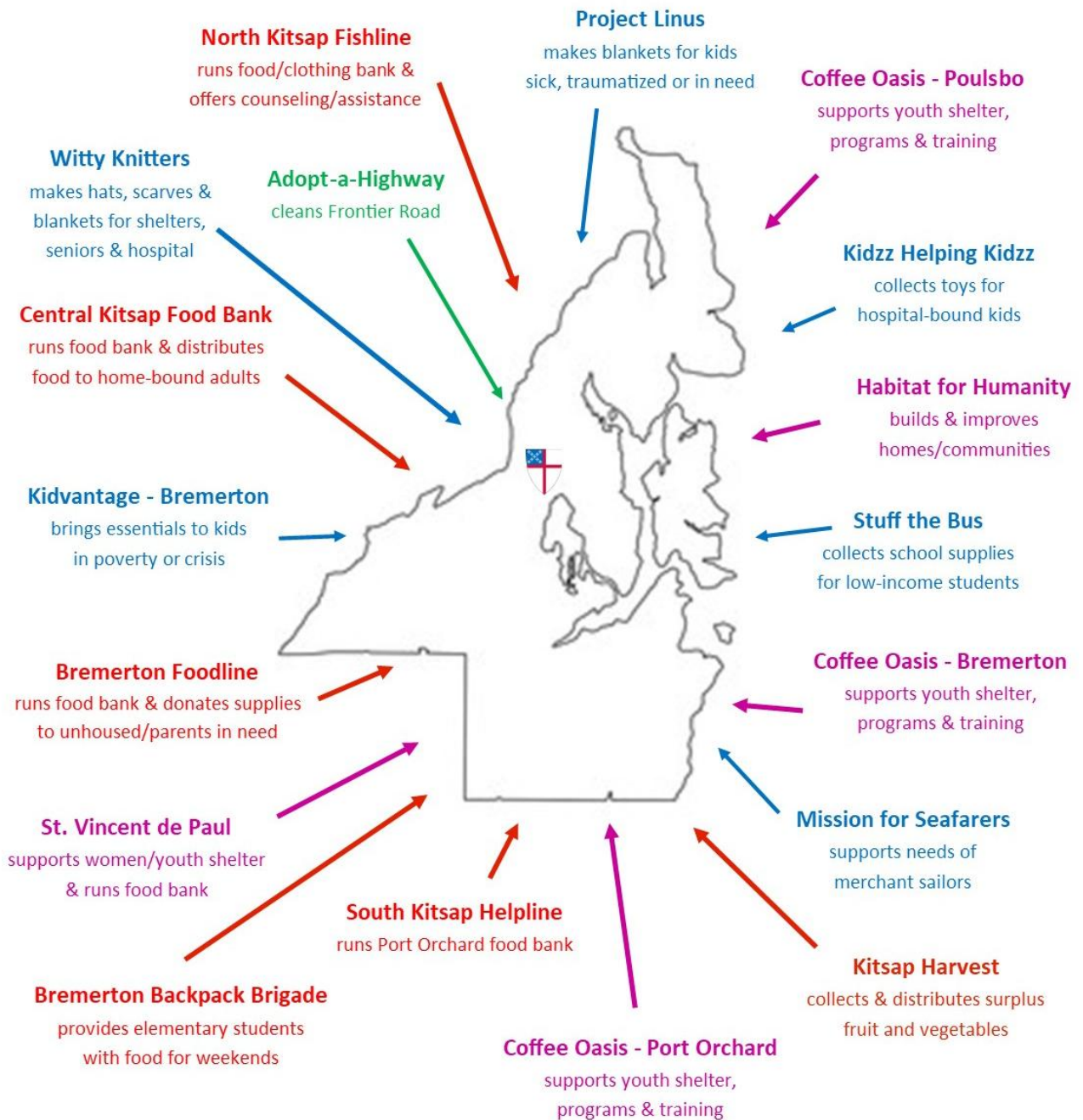

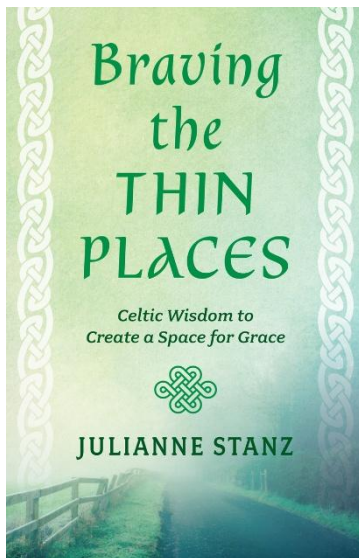

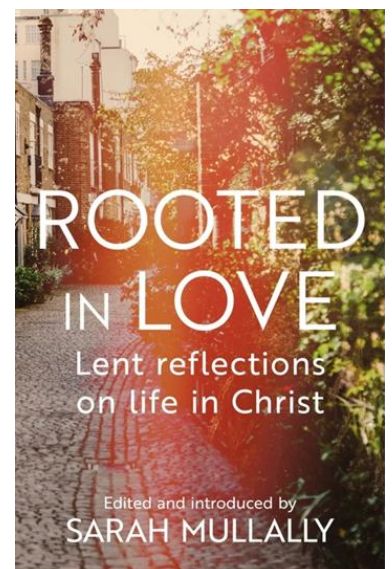


Lenten Soup Suppers
